[LACCOTAM 2012](#) is the second conference organized by the Latin American and Caribbean Congress for Theoretical and Applied Mechanics and aims to bring together researchers and scientists of the region for communicating recent and projected advances in all fields of theoretical and applied mechanics.

The activity will be held in Caracas, Venezuela, on September 24 to 26, 2012 in collaboration with Universidad Simón Bolívar, Universidad Central de Venezuela, Universidad de los Andes and The University of West Indies.
